

# VA Information Sheet

## **Chapter 33 –Post 9/11 GI Bill**

- ▶ Must have served in military at least 90 days after September 11, 2001.  
The Percent of their benefit is based on length of service.
- ▶ Student may be the veteran or the child or spouse of the veteran
- ▶ How is the Post 9/11 benefit paid?  
Tuition/Fees are paid directly to DTCC and applied to student account  
BAH (Basic Allowance for Housing) is paid to student monthly as long as the following criteria are met;
  1. Must be enrolled in at least 7 credit hours to receive BAH- Must be enrolled full time for fall entitlement.
  2. At least one class must be in-residence (seated). The other classes can all be online.

## **Chapter 30 (Montgomery GI Bill), Chapter 35 (Dependents Education Assistance), Chapters 1606/1607**

- ▶ How are 30, 35, 1606, 1607 paid?  
Monthly stipends are paid directly to students after term begins. If student is not receiving financial aid, he must be prepared to pay for classes out of pocket and will get reimbursed when payments begin after the start of classes.
- ▶ These benefits are paid based on a pro-rated basis. Student does NOT have  
to be enrolled full time. Student must be full time to receive maximum benefit. Less than full time is prorated.

## **Chapter 31 – Vocational Rehabilitation**

- ▶ Student must have a service - related disability rating of at least 10 percent
