

Three bi-lingual AmeriCorps Members are needed at Family Violence & Rape Crisis Services in Pittsboro, N.C. (20-25 minutes from Chapel Hill) to work with Spanish and English-speaking victims of domestic and sexual violence. There are one part-time and two fulltime positions, beginning Sept. 1st. An annual living stipend, plus health insurance and education award are granted. Requirements include ability to speak both English and Spanish, at least a high school diploma or GED by the end of the service year, and US citizenship or legal permanent residency. Some of the Americorps members in the past have held the position while in school. Some Americorps members have worked while applying for graduate school. The Americorps members will receive extensive training in crisis intervention and will have the opportunity to experience grass-roots work in Latino communities, one in Siler City.
