COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Prerequisites: ENG 080 or satisfactory score on placement test

Corequisites: ENG 090

This writing lab is designed for practicing the skills introduced in ENG 090. Emphasis is on learning and applying the conventions of standard written English in developing paragraphs within the essay. Upon completion, students should be able to compose a variety of paragraphs and a unified, coherent essay. Course Hours Per Week: Lab, 2. Semester Hours Credit, 1.

- a. Improve English usage skills.
- b. Produce drafts of writing assignments.
- c. Revise and edit writing assignments.
