COMPOSITION STRATEGIES LAB

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Prerequisites: ENG 080 or satisfactory score on placement test

Corequisites: ENG 090

This writing lab is designed for practicing the skills introduced in ENG 090. Emphasis is on learning and applying the conventions of standard written English in developing paragraphs within the essay. Upon completion, students should be able to compose a variety of paragraphs and a unified, coherent essay. Course Hours Per Week: Lab, 2. Semester Hours Credit, 1.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

At the completion of this course, the student will be able to:

- a. Compose well-developed, coherent paragraphs and essays in standard written English.
- b. Apply knowledge of standard written English to edit written text.
- c. Use strategies to locate and evaluate appropriate research.
- d. Incorporate research into academic writing using MLA guidelines.
- e. Prepare and deliver oral presentation.
- f. Use word processing software to draft and edit written work.
- g. Show proficiency in use of e-mail, the Internet, and Blackboard
