North Carolina Central University (NCCU) is seeking applicants for a scholarship competition for students interested in enrolling in the Biomanufacturing Research Institute and Technology Enterprise (BRITE) Center of Excellence during fall 2007. The BRITE Program offers an exciting curriculum for students who are interested in pursuing a career in the biotech industry. Participants in the program will major in biology, chemistry or physics with a concentration in biopharmaceuticals.

To be eligible for consideration for a BRITE scholarship award, you must be either a first time freshman, a community college transfer with an associate's degree or a rising junior. You must also meet the minimum requirements below. The deadline to submit the application is January 15, 2007. Scholarship winners will be selected by February 15, 2007.

FIRST TIME FRESHMAN MUST:

- Have a 3.5 or better GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Score at least 1750 on the SAT or a minimum of 650 on the math portion of the test or at least 28 on the ACT
- Submit the completed application with a 500 word essay on why you are the best candidate for the BRITE Scholarship Submit an official transcript
- Participate in an interview with the Selection Committee

COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER OR NCCU RISING JUNIOR MUST:

- Have a 3.5 or better GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Participate in an interview with selection committee
- Submit the completed application with a 500 word essay on why you are the best candidate for the BRITE Scholarship
- Submit an official transcript
- Submit three professional letters of recommendation
- Complete science prerequisites
