- Degree requires CIS113 (DLT)
- Demonstration of computer competency is a graduation requirement (A.D.N., OTA, PHM)

§§ Placement test scores for the COMPASS, ASSET, ACCUPLACER, SAT, and ACT are good for <u>five years</u> from the date taken regardless of where they were taken. If test scores are older than five years, students must retest using COMPASS unless <u>continuously enrolled</u> in classes (see definition below for "continuous enrollment").

NOTE: If students need to take developmental math courses, they can now be directed to the new, computer based, self-paced developmental math modules. Course sections using this model are designated with an "E".

All new students are now <u>required</u> to complete a ConnectSession. Information about ConnectSessions is available at <u>http://www.durhamtech.edu/html/current/orientation.htm</u>. Students will be exempt from the Connect Session if they meet the following (same waiver as for ACA):

- Those who produce evidence of holding a college-level diploma or higher from a regionally accredited institution; or
- Those who receive at least 12 hours college-level transfer credit for academic work completed in the past ten years; or
- Those who have completed at least 12 hours of college-level academic work at Durham Tech in the past ten years

Program Information Sessions for programs other than nursing are <u>optional but recommended</u>. The schedule for program information sessions is available online. Nursing information sessions are mandatory!

New college students should take ACA 122 in their first semester of enrollment (second semester at the latest). The following students are waived from the ACA 122 requirement but may still need to fulfill the one-credit hour on their plans of study:

- Those who produce evidence of holding a college-level diploma or higher from a regionally accredited institution; or
- Those who receive at least 12 hours college-level transfer credit for academic work completed in the past ten years; or
- Those who have completed at least 12 hours of college-level academic work at Durham Tech in the past ten years; or
- Those who have completed an ACA course at the 100-level or above from Durham Tech or another North Carolina Community College in the past ten years.

MAT080 must be taken as a prerequisite course for MAT151 Statistics for students enrolled in the CTRA AAS or Level I certificate. This is not required as an admissions step but must be satisfied prior to the student's registration into MAT151. The MAT080 requirement can be met by achieving at least a 66 on the COMPASS Algebra test or taking MAT080 or transferring in a college algebra course (ex. MAT161).
