Apply online:

- \$5-\$10 with modem
- Service availability and speed may vary by address
- Access to AT&T Wi-Fi Hot Spot network included

- At least one member receives FNS benefits (Food Stamps)
- At least one member participates in the National School Lunch Program (free or reduced lunch) or Head Start*

Apply online:

- \$14.99/month with free internet modem
- High-speed internet at 30 Mbps
- Optional in-home Wi-Fi service for \$5/month

One of more members of your household must be a recipient of one of the following programs:

- National School Lunch Program (free or reduced lunch)
- Community Eligibility Provision of the National School Lunch Program (meaning attend a school where all students are able to receive free lunch)
- Receives Supplemental Security Income and is age 65+

- High speed unlimited 4G LTE service for \$15/month
- \$60-\$80 one-time equipment fee for mobile hotspot
- Coverage through Sprint 4G LTE network

To qualify, a potential recipient must earn below 200% of the federal poverty level **or** be currently enrolled in an income-based government assistance program, including: Pell Grant, Food Stamps, unemployment, National School Lunch, and more.
