WBL 121 Work Based Learning II

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Prerequisites: Permission of academic advisor and Work-Based Learning Coordinator Corequisites: None

This course provides a work-based learning experience with a college-approved employer in an area related to the student's program of study. Emphasis is placed on integrating classroom learning with related work experience. Upon completion, students should be able to evaluate career selection, demonstrate employability skills, and satisfactorily perform work-related competencies.

Course Hours per Week: Class, 1; Work, 10. Semester Hours Credit, 1.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Upon completing requirements for this course, the student will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate the knowledge and skills needed to complete tasks needed to perform work duties of a profession related to the selected plan of study.
- 2. Understand the daily tasks for the profession related to the selected plan of study.
 - a. Demonstrate the ability to carry out the expectations of employer.
 - b. Develop a strong and positive work ethic.
 - c. Demonstrate knowledge of the workplace regulations related to the profession related to the selected plan of study.
