	Apply to Durham Tech at durhamtech.edu/apply. If you have not attended for 3 semesters, you must reapply.			
	Submit official transcripts showing proof of completion of high school or a GED via an approved transcript service (NSCH, Parchment, etc.) DIRECTLY to transcripts@durhamtech.edu			
	Apply for financial aid at www.durhamtech.edu/pay-college/financial-aid to complete the FAFSA. Durham Tech's school code is 005448. Please note that you cannot receive financial aid until you have been admitted to an eligible program.			
	Attend the mandatory information session. Register for the appropriate info session at https://www.durhamtech.edu/events or by using the following QR code. Info session attendance is valid for one calendar year.			
	Demonstrate "college-readiness" by meeting course placement requirements in one of the following ways: Output Proof of an unweighted high school GPA of 2.8 or higher (must be a US high school) Proof of an associate or bachelor's degree Transfer college credit for English Place out of Dev. Ed coursework via Durham Tech's English placement test Successfully complete ENG 025			
	□ Demonstrate English language proficiency. If English is not your first language and/or you did not attend a US high school, you will need the English for Academic Purposes (EAP) department to verify that you meet English language proficiency requirements for the Health & Wellness programs
