

Accessing the tutorial on Canvas


Before you can access the tutorial, you must “join” the site in Canvas:

1. Use this link to add the tutorial to Canvas:
[Add Academic Integrity & Plagiarism Tutorial to Canvas](#)
2. Login with your Canvas username and password.
3. Add the course. Then click **GO TO THE COURSE**.
4. If you clicked on **GO TO YOUR DASHBOARD** instead, just choose the **Academic Integrity & Plagiarism Tutorial** course from your dashboard to access it.

To access the tutorial (after joining):

1. Click **COURSES** on the left menu.
2. You should see **Academic Integrity & Plagiarism Tutorial** in your list of courses. Click it.
3. You are now in the tutorial!
4. You do not have to complete the tutorial in one sitting – you can leave and come back later and pick up where you left off.
5. When you come back, you do not have to “join” again – just click on **COURSES** to access the tutorial from now on.

Complete the eight (8) lessons in order. Each lesson has some questions that you must answer.

- You cannot move on to the next lesson until you answer all questions (right or wrong).
- After you complete all eight (8) lessons, you can take the **Final Assessment**.
- You must score 80 or higher on the Final Assessment to earn a Certificate of Completion.
- You can re-take the Final Assessment as many times as needed to attain a score of 80.

Getting your Certificate of Completion

- To receive their certificate, students must proceed to the page following the final assessment. There they will see a PDF document they can download as proof of their completion of the tutorial.
