FIP 276 Managing Fire Services (3 SHC) or FIP 2276A (ConEd)

**Major Electives** – Choose a minimum of 17 semester hours credit from any PST course plus the following courses: **CJC 111**, CJC 112, CJC 113, **CJC 121**, CJC 131, CJC 132, CJC 141, CJC 212, CJC 221, CJC 231, CJC 232, EMS 110, EPT 220, **HIS 111**, HIS 131, **HUM 110**, **POL 120**, POL 220, PSY 150, SOC 210. **NOTE:** Students are limited to 9 SHC of PST courses towards program completion.
